



## Report on the feedback about curriculum from stake holders 2019-20

Feedback on curriculum is obtained by the stake holders i.e. students, teachers, alumnae and employer. The questionnaire of the feedback was circulated through the Google form. For the students feedback complete anonymity of the student is maintained.

### • Students' Feedback

The feedback is taken from students of all years of undergrad programs. The critical findings from the analysis are as follows;

- Tutorials are helping students to grasp the core concepts of the syllabus.
- Students are inclined to have humanities subjects as part of the curriculum
- Introduction of audit courses is well received by the students
- Student expects more transparency in the assessment process
- Although the current courses are adequate to understand the engineering fundamentals, students are interested in having more choice based courses in the curriculum
- Students are of the opinion to make internship as a part of the revised curriculum
- Students who have undergone the internship in an industry think that the minimum duration of the internship should be of 6 months

### • Alumnae Feedback

Alumnae feedback is crucial in design of revised curriculum as these stake holders can help most to the bridge the gap between academia and industry. The questionnaire of alumnae feedback is mainly based on the inclusion of more number of choice based courses and internship. The key points from alumnae feedback are as given below;

- The courses include in the syllabus are as per the industry needs
- Many alumnae felt that the number of choice based courses are sufficient, some still of the opinion are number of choice based courses should be more
- All alumnae expressed the need of making internship mandatory for engineering students
- About the Internship duration alumnae feel that six months are adequate to get acquainted with the industry function and complete a small project

- **Employer Feedback**

Employers' feedback reflects industry's expectation about curriculum from the institute. Employers' feedback is obtained from renowned industries visiting Cummins college for campus placements. The foremost observations reported by the industry are as follows;

- The current curriculum is based on the industry requirements about technological knowhow of the students and generate placement opportunity for the students
- Considering the rapidly changing technological scenario across the globe, more number of choice based courses and interdisciplinary subjects should be offered to the students.
- Six months Internship should be a mandatory part of the curriculum
- Humanities subjects should be included in the curriculum
- The domain experts of the industry have suggested various topics and courses for inclusion in the revised curriculum.

The detailed analysis of feedback suggestions received from the stake holders is conveyed to the Chairman Board of Studies of various departments for further action.



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
